

# Wedding accommodation for your guests

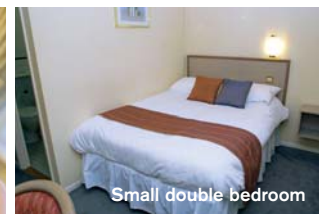
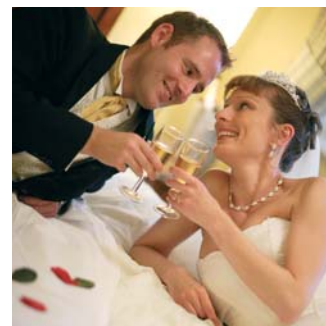
There are 150 double ensuite bedrooms available at The Willows all on ground floor level. The rooms are tastefully decorated with central heating, showers (no baths), tea and coffee making facilities, hairdryer, full length mirrors and colour television.

Due to the size of the bedrooms, (which are smaller than the normal expected family size rooms), special preferential accommodation rates are offered which include a full English or Continental breakfast. We have a small number of standard double rooms which can accommodate a child's fold-out bed.

Check-in time for guests staying at The Willows is from 5.00 pm on a Friday.

Larger, recently refurbished twin rooms with private baths and showers are available at Wyboston Lakes Hotel, our AA 3 star venue, which is a short walk from The Willows. These rooms can accommodate an extra bed for a child if required. Please be aware that the rooms at Wyboston Lakes Hotel are outside of the wedding package bedroom prices and will attract a supplement. Wyboston Lakes is situated 18 miles west of Cambridge, close to the A1/A428 interchange on the Bedfordshire/Cambridgeshire border and within one hour's drive of London and the Midlands.

## How to find us



### BY ROAD FROM NORTH OR SOUTH

Leave A1 at A428 junction (signposted Cambridge) just south of St. Neots. From North, take third exit at roundabout. From South, take fourth exit at roundabout (back towards A1). Flags mark the entrance to Wyboston Lakes.

### BY ROAD FROM EAST

From Cambridge and M11, take A428 (signposted Bedford). Take first exit at roundabout just before junction with A1. Flags mark the entrance to Wyboston Lakes.

### BY ROAD FROM WEST

From Bedford and M1, take A421 (signposted Cambridge). Join A1 North and leave at A428 junction (signposted Cambridge). Take fourth exit at roundabout (back towards A1). Flags mark the entrance to Wyboston Lakes.

### BY RAIL

The nearest railway station is at St. Neots. This is connected with London King's Cross by a frequent 48 minute service. The station is a 10 minute taxi ride from Wyboston Lakes.

### BY AIR

Both Luton and Stansted airports are approximately one hour's drive away.
